I have abbreviated the instructions below.

First, if you do not have an iStar username and password, you will need to visit the iStar website at <http://istar-chla.usc.edu> to request a username.

If you already have an iStar account, you can go directly to the Citi training site:

Instructions are below:

1. Click on the red hyperlink, Register for the CITI Course .
2. Under the Participating Institutions drop down menu, locate University of Southern California and highlight. Click the submit button
3. Choose a username and password (it does not have to be your iStar username). Click the submit button.
4. Fill in the required fields in the registration form. Click the submit information button.
5. Select a group appropriate to your research activities. If you are unsure of what user group applies to you, contact the CITI helpdesk.
6. Choose yes or no if you have completed the basic course in the protection of research subjects. Click the submit button.
7. You may start your online education.
